Introduction

This document describes two sets of output tables on Approximated Social Grade (ASG) that MRS has commissioned from the 2001 Census.

The first set of outputs are designed to replace and improve upon the ASG tables that were released as part of the main Census results, by excluding the age groups for which there were accuracy issues - see <u>http://www.mrs.org.uk/networking/cgg/cggsocialgrade.htm</u> for further information.

The second set consists of theme tables on Approximated Social Grade cross-analysed by demographics, for countries within the UK. These tables are designed to help understand the ASG results.
